### What is the meaning?

1. What is the “therefore” there for?
2. We are to be “preparing our minds for action”. What does that mean?
3. We are to be “sober-minded”. How is that different from “preparing our minds for action”?
4. Peter tells us to “set our hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.” What is that grace?
5. According to Peter, how should “preparing our minds” and being “sober-minded” relate to our “being filled with hope”?
6. What are the passions of our “former ignorance” to which we are no longer to be conformed?
7. We are to be holy because God is holy. What does it mean that God is holy?
8. Are there ways we can’t be holy like God? Explain.
9. In what ways does Peter intend us to be holy like God?

### How does it apply?

1. Based upon the organization of the letter, what is Peter trying to establish as the motivation for our obedience? Why is that important?
2. How does/should being filled with hope in future grace impact us now? Is it working? Why or why not?
3. What do we forfeit by not pursuing holiness? What do we gain by pursuing it?
4. Is there anything that God is calling you to do or change in order that you might be more “hope-filled” and “holy”?

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
